

## Small Group Questions June 8, 2025 Sermon: Lost & Found Luke 15:1-10

- 1. What people are represented in Luke 15:1-3?
- 2. What of their background, leading up to this encounter, do you recall about these people?
- 3. Who are the "characters" (one is inanimate) in Luke 15:4-7 and Luke 15:8-10? How do the "characters" in these 2 parables represent the people in Luke 15:1-3?
- 4. Compare these parables. What do you notice is similar? What do you notice is different?
- 5. In a large sense, we know Jesus' telling of these parables is for all of us, as well as all the people in Luke 15:1-3. But, if you had to name one of these people in Luke 15:1-3 as the major intended hearers, who would it be and why them?
- 6. What is a parable? Explain what is being compared in these 2 parables. What does it mean to us? To you?
- 7. Does modern Christendom most closely represent Jesus, the "sinners," or the Pharisees? Which one most closely represents Grace Mesa? Which one most closely represents you?
- 8. How will you respond? How should Grace Mesa respond?
