**Jude 1:5-16**

1. Where do you see the increasing attitudes of unbelief, rebellion, and immorality in our culture? Name some of them. How can these creep into the church?
2. Why do you think its so hard to trust God in the present and so easy to look forward to what God might do in the future?
3. Are you content with and confident that God knows what he is doing in your life? Or, is your heart gripped by a spirit of rebellion, especially if you suspect what God has for you is not what you want for yourself?
4. How does sexual perversion consume a person? How can we lovingly confront someone engaged in sexual sin?
5. What is antinomianism and why is it dangerous in the church? On the flip side, how should we view the role or rules/ law?
6. How do we know where to draw boundaries, so the church does not get its marching orders and goals from the world?
7. Is it easy or difficult to submit to authority (consider each: family, government & church)? Why? Are there ways or areas of your life you reject God-given authority over you?
8. Rejecting one's place in God economy is a serious rejection of God's authority. It is a statement that we know better for ourselves and what role we should have than God. Can you think of other biblical accounts of someone rejecting their place in God's economy? Are there ways in our culture you see people rejecting God's role for them?
